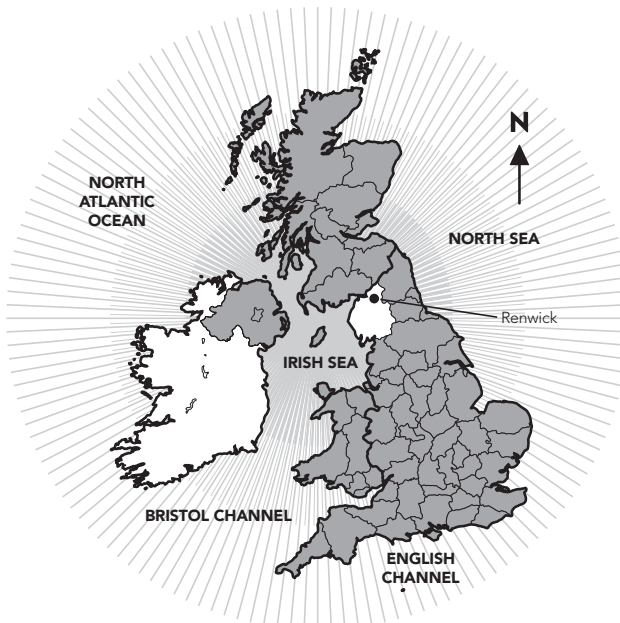

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**WHITE WINE****175ml 250ml Bottle****PIROPO PINOT BLANC**

Argentina, 2010 ..... 5.00 ..... 6.95 ..... 21.50  
Medium-bodied, its fresh and fruity pear and apple aromas are balanced by crisp citrus characters, plus ripe apricot and peach flavours.

**CLIFFORD'S HILL SAUVIGNON BLANC**

Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2010 ..... 6.50 ..... 9.00 ..... 26.75  
A brilliant Sauvignon from the Cape coast – handcrafted in memory of Clifford Hill, raconteur, adventurer and lover of wine. Well balanced and elegantly intense. Cliff would have approved.

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**RED WINE****175ml 250ml Bottle****FICO GRANDE SANGIOVESE DI ROMAGNA PODERI DAL NESPOLI**

Italy, 2010 ..... 4.75 ..... 6.50 ..... 19.50  
A soft and supple wine - it carries lovely red fruit characteristics and a hint of spice and pepper, followed by long, smooth tannins.

**CHILCAS CARMENERE RESERVA**

Chile, 2010 ..... 6.00 ..... 8.25 ..... 25.50  
Attractive and intense, the nose reveals fruit aromas such as strawberry, raspberry, and black plum. Great volume and silky tannins on the palate.

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**BEER****Per Bottle****MONTERREY**

Central America, 4.0% 355ml ..... 3.75  
A refreshing pale lager from brewers 'Cerveceria Centro Americana' set in the heart of Guatemala City. This light and crisp lager features a pleasant aroma and is perfect served chilled with or without lime. Incidentally, the lime was not traditionally served with Cervezas (Spanish for beer) but used as a tool to stop insects entering the bottle!

**TSINGTAO**

China, 5.0% 330ml ..... 3.75  
Tsingtao has been brewed in China for over a century, and has established itself as the Emperor of China's export beer market. Brewed from the finest of ingredients including home grown hops, barley and only the purest spring water from China's stunning Laoshan mountains. Crisp, slightly malty and with an undercurrent of sweet nut; we say enough rabbiting on - get me another!

**GOD LAGER**

Sweden, 5.3% 300ml ..... 4.50  
"Good God!" We hear you cry. With a quick 'thank you' to the Swedes, and a little interpretation we'll tell you that 'God' simply means 'good'. The Nils Oscar brewery harvests its own grain, malts the grain in its own malt house and brews the beer all under one roof, ensuring total control from grain to glass. Featuring a really good strong malt profile this slightly darker-than-your-average beer, also boasts a thicker texture due to the unpasteurised process which gives the beer a mouthwateringly fresh taste.

**BLACK SHEEP**

England, 4.7% 500ml ..... 5.00  
A traditional and independent brew from Masham, North Yorkshire. Made from crystal clear Dales water, Mans Otter malted barley, some wheat to fortify the beers' natural head, a little roasted malt for colour and flavour, generous amounts of whole English hops. A really refreshing little number that no-one would be ashamed to have in the family!
